ORDER AND JUDGMENT

This matter is before the Court for entry of the Judgment in these cases. The Court previously entered an order dated November 14, 1996, which held that the debts Hien Duc Le owed

to Avco Financial Services of Alabama, Inc., First Family Financial Services, and First North American National Bank and Circuit City Stores, Inc. were nondischargeable debts pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(2). The Court gave the creditors 15 days to file affidavits requesting attorneys fees and costs, if appropriate, pursuant to the contract of the parties. The Debtor was then given 15 days to respond to the request. First Family Financial Services requested \$950 in attorneys fees and \$120 in court costs. The First Family contract provides for recovery of such fees and costs, if reasonable. The Debtor did not respond to the request. The Court finds the request to be reasonable.

THEREFORE IT IS ADJUDGED:

1. Avco Financial Services of Alabama, Inc. is awarded a judgment against Hien Duc Le in the amount of Three Thousand Eight Hundred Seven and 23/100ths Dollars (\$3,807.23) and the debt is declared to be nondischargeable in his bankruptcy case pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(2);

2. First Family Financial Services is awarded a judgment against Hien Duc Le in the amount of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Nine and 69/100ths Dollars (\$2,779.69) and the debt is declared to be nondischargeable in Debtor's bankruptcy case pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(2);

3. First North American National Bank is awarded a judgment against Hien Duc Le in the amount of Two Thousand Four Hundred Nineteen and 76/100ths Dollars (\$2,419.76) and the debt is declared to be nondischargeable in Debtor's bankruptcy case pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(2); and

4. Circuit City Stores, Inc., is awarded a judgment against Hien Duc Le in the amount of Four Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Four and 48/100ths Dollars (\$4,774.48) and the debt is declared to be nondischargeable in Debtor's bankruptcy case pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(2).
