**FINAL ORDER ON MOTION OF OSTER & WEGENER, P.L.C.**  
**TO DETERMINE VALIDITY OF LIEN**

On August 3, 1999, the Court entered a preliminary order granting the motion of Oster & Wegener to determine the validity of its lien, and giving the parties 14 days from the date of the order to submit briefs on the issue of whether the military retirement benefit which the Debtor receives from her former husband is exempt under federal or state law. The Court subsequently granted the Debtor's request for 14 additional days to submit a brief on August 30, 1999. The parties did not submit briefs. Therefore, the Court finds that the order of August 3, 1999 determining that Oster & Wegener P.L.C. has a valid lien is final. It is hereby

**ORDERED** that the Court's order of August 3, 1999 is **FINAL**, and the privilege of Oster & Wegener, P.L.C. is valid.
