




DISCONTINUATION OF CHAPTER 13 PLAN PAYMENTS ON A SECURED CLAIM
AFTER RELIEF FROM STAY

Unless otherwise ordered, if the court grants relief from stay as to collateral in a chapter 13 case, the trustee is directed to discontinue plan distributions on the creditor's claim secured by that collateral unless and until the creditor files an amended proof of claim reflecting any deficiency remaining after disposition of the collateral. The trustee shall file and serve on the creditor a notice of payment discontinuation incorporating the terms of this order.
