PAYMENT OF FILING FEES IN A CHAPTER 13 CASE

1. In a chapter 13 case, no application to pay the filing fee in installments is required if the plan provides for the fee to be paid from plan payments.

2. Filing fees being paid through a chapter 13 plan shall be paid to the clerk of court by the chapter 13 trustee as an administrative expense in lump sum after sufficient funds are on hand and before any other case disbursements. The trustee shall be allowed the standard commission on all filing fee disbursements.

3. The chapter 13 trustee's office shall not submit a proposed order confirming the debtor's plan until filing fees have been paid in full, per Bankruptcy Code § 1325(a)(2).
