
REQUIREMENT FOR WAGE WITHHOLDING OR TFS IN CHAPTER 13 CASES

This order applies to chapter 13 cases filed April 1, 2023 or later. Unless excused by the trustee or the court, at the time they file their chapter 13 plan debtors shall either (a) file a request for their employer to withhold wages by check or through TFS Employer Pay in an amount equal to their monthly plan payment to be remitted to the trustee, or (b) set up automatic payments to the trustee through TFS Billpay System (www.tfsbillpay.com) in an amount equal to their monthly plan payment. Debtors may arrange for payments to be made on a weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly basis. Debtors who seek to be excused from this requirement must provide satisfactory evidence to the chapter 13 trustee (at the meeting of creditors or otherwise) that they cannot reasonably comply with it. The trustee may move to dismiss or object to confirmation if debtors have not complied with this requirement or satisfactorily shown why they cannot do so.
