FILINGS USING GENERATIVE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

Effective September 1, 2026, any pleadings, motion, or paper (whether moving, opposing, or in reply) prepared in any aspect by using a generative artificial intelligence (“AI”) program must include or be accompanied by a disclosure and certification by the filer:

- Identifying the AI program used, and
- Certifying that the filer checked the document for factual and legal accuracy using print reporters, traditional legal databases, or other reliable means.

Rule 9011 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure continues to apply to all documents filed with the court.
