
ACCEPTABLE METHODS OF FEE PAYMENT

The clerk of court is authorized and directed to accept fee payments pursuant to the methods set out below. All checks or money orders must be made payable to "Clerk, U.S. Bankruptcy Court."

- a. From attorneys and other electronic filers: Pay.Gov using a credit or debit card.  
With express permission of the clerk or chief deputy clerk in an unusual circumstance, a law firm check will be accepted.
- b. For all other fees not related to an electronic filing: cash in the exact amount (no change provided), cashier's check, money order, or check written on a designated chapter 11 debtor-in-possession account.
