
DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS ON HAND UPON DISMISSAL
OF A CHAPTER 13 CASE PRIOR TO CONFIRMATION

If a Chapter 13 case is dismissed prior to entry of a confirmation order, the Chapter 13 trustee is directed to apply the funds on hand, after payment of the trustee's commission, in the following priority:

1. Any unpaid filing fees, per Bankruptcy Rule 1006(b)(3).
2. Attorney's fees to counsel for debtor(s) in the amount of \$1,000 (taking into account any amounts paid prepetition), per Bankruptcy Code § 503(b)(2) and Administrative Order 2019-3.
3. Refund to debtor(s) by check made payable to debtor(s) and mailed to their current address, regardless of any power of attorney or other contractual arrangement, per Bankruptcy Code § 1326(a)(2).
