ORDER AMENDING ORDER DENYING DISCHARGE OF DEBTOR

On September 13, 2005, the court entered an order denying the discharge of the debtor, James Harvey Tipler. By that order, the court denied the debtor's discharge pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 727(a)(2), (3), and (4). However, due to a typographical error, the wrong subsections of 11 U.S.C. § 727(a) were cited in the last line of the first page of the order. This order amends the September 13, 2005 order for the sole purpose of correcting the typographical error to clarify that the debtor's discharge was denied pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 727(a)(2), (3), and (4). The remainder of the original order is otherwise unchanged.
